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11. If you had been a Native American leader at the time, would you have welcomed Lewis & Clark in friendship? Explain.

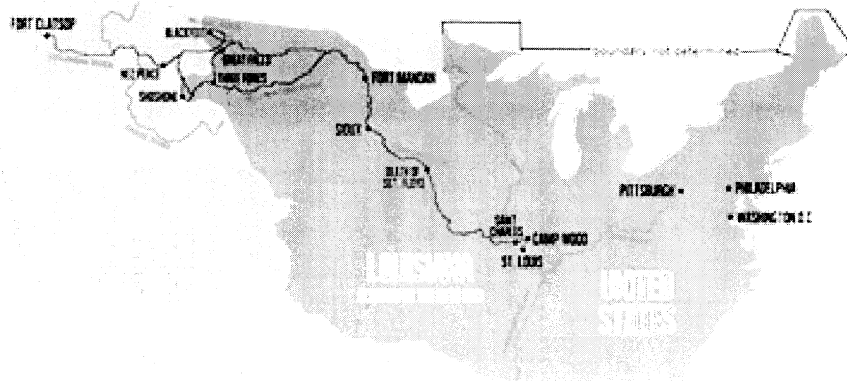
