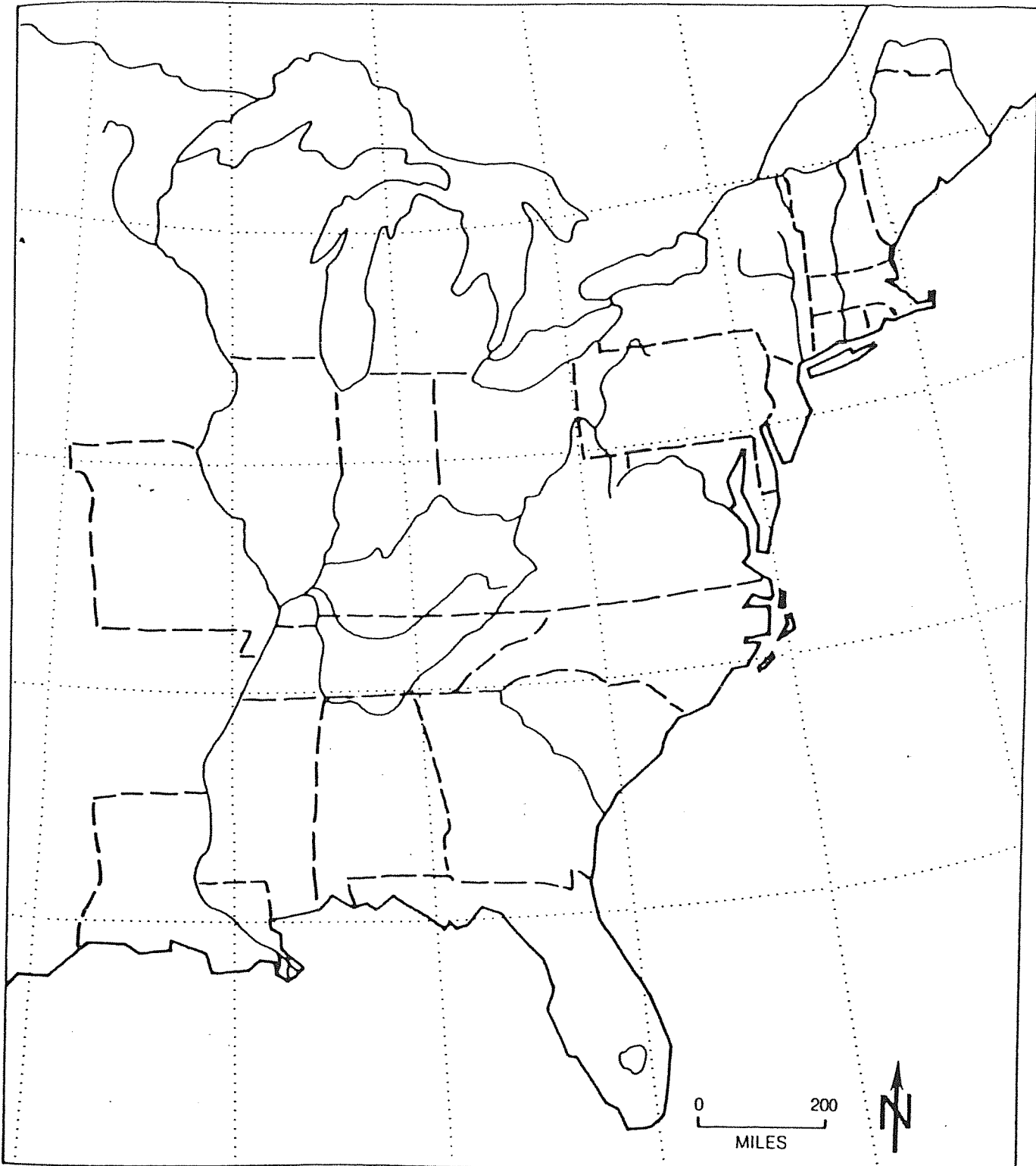


## 14. Expansion of United States to 1833
